## A practical guide to Goonhavern Show

Entries for the Show can be made until **8pm on Tuesday 11th July**. Entry forms can be left at Bridge Stores, the School Office or at Roselyn, Newquay Road Goonhavern or enter online @ **www.goonhavern.net**.

This allows us the time to book all of the entries in and to know the number of entries in each class so we can prepare and mark out the hall and marquee in advance and for these reasons, late entries cannot be accepted.

You will need to bring your exhibits to be staged either on the **Friday evening between 7pm & 10pm or on the Saturday between 8am and 10am**.

When you arrive, please go to the hatch by the office and the Secretary will have an envelope ready for you. This will contain the class cards for each of the entries you have made. You will need to locate the class numbers of the classes you have entered either in the hall or the marquee. Place your entry into the class with the corresponding number on your class card, placing the card with your exhibit – stewards will be on hand to help and point you in the correct direction.

Please note that because we have to hang all of the **Children's flat artwork**, these exhibits need to be handed in earlier and need to be given in to school or the secretary by **Monday 10th July** at the latest. Please can the child's name and age be written on the reverse of these exhibits as class cards are not used on these exhibits.

On Show Day the **judging begins at 10am** when all of the exhibits must have been staged and the Show opens again to the **public at 2.15pm**. Lots of work goes on in between those times and afterwards to work out who has won the awards and all will be revealed at **prize giving at 4.30pm**. We ask that **all exhibits remain staged until 5pm**.

## General Rules:

- 1 The decision of the judges appointed by the Show Committee will be final.
- 2 THREE entries accepted in each class.
- 3 In the event of a tie for most points, most first prizes will be awarded a point.
- 4 **Winners of trophies must give a written guarantee of safekeeping whilst held and must return them to the show secretary by 10 June 2017.**
- 5 **Exhibits not to have been entered previously at Goonhavern Show.**
- 6 **Novice Classes are confined to Exhibitors who have never won a first prize in an Open section of any show or do not earn their living in the class subject.**
- 7 The committee reserve the right to visit any garden/greenhouse of an exhibitor prior to the show.
- 8 All exhibits must be made or grown by the exhibitor (except floral art section).
- 9 All vases and boards to be provided by the exhibitor unless stated in schedule.
- 10 **The committee will exercise care with exhibits but will NOT be held responsible for accidents or lost items.**
- 11 Admission to the show is free for exhibitors who enter 10 or more entries.
- 12 **Cars are parked in the Show Car Park at their own risk.**
- 13 Car Parking available at Goonhavern School Infant Playground, access via Newquay Rd
- 14 Prize money will be paid at 5.30pm.

There will be stalls, refreshments, bouncy castle and a band to keep you entertained whilst visiting the show in the afternoon.

We are very proud of our Village Show and would like to encourage as many people as possible to enter the show and display their many talents so why not join in this year. We are always happy to accept any offers of help on or around Show Day and would welcome any new members on to the committee.
